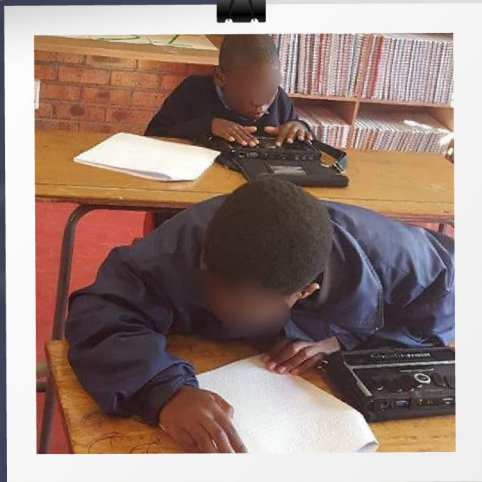
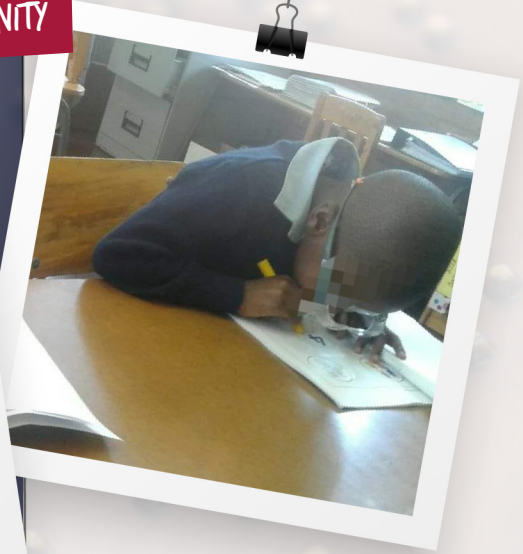

WHO IS JICAMA 89?

Jicama 89 is a non-profit and a P.B.O organisation with a primary purpose of supporting underprivileged and deserving organisations in their efforts to provide for less fortunate and able individuals. Our vision is to create educational and social upliftment of young individuals by supporting and fostering their development to reach their full potential.

PROJECT: ENRICHING THE LIVES OF THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED

Jicama 89 is currently concerned with supporting children in the care of the Sibonile School for the visually impaired, based in Klipriver, South of Johannesburg. We strive to bring about awareness of the task of educating children with visual impairment. For us to have maximum impact, we understand that we have to provide these children with a conducive learning environment suited to their specific needs and stimulate their educational growth. We further aim to present the youth with equal opportunities and ensure that they are treated fairly and protected in the eyes of the Constitution.

The Sibonile School provides schooling, accommodation, food, and clothing for almost 173 children, who are partially sighted, totally blind or deaf and blind. Our goal is to prepare the Visually Impaired learners for successful integration in society where they can provide a meaningful contribution. Sibonile would greatly benefit from establishing a vocational training centre for the blind (inner vision centre), empowering the visually impaired in:

- Self-awareness training
- Health education and healing
- Small business courses
- Self-employment or making the impaired employable
- Adult basic education
- Skills training in the production of goods

Jicama 89 main focus for the past 3 years has been on replacing the outdated Braille Typewriter system with a computer-based system, Braille Note Taking system that greatly improves the interaction between the Teacher and the Learner. However, because it is a specialised product, it is very costly. The school is in need of funding to improve their accommodation facilities as well as equipment. Clothing, blankets, food, specialised books and stationery are always a desperate need.
